

Make your own mini-greenhouse!

If you want your sunflower to have the best chances to thrive, make it a mini-greenhouse!

This project will give your plant a welcoming environment. The translucent material will let the light shine all the way into this little shelter and help your sunflower grow.

Ready? Here's what you need to do.

1 water bottle (5 L jug)

Scissors

Tape

A small tray (just big enough to hold the bottle on its side)





Horizontal version

1. An adult (your teacher, for example) will cut out the side of the bottle. This will become the opening of your greenhouse.
2. For the horizontal version, place the bottle, opening on the bottom, on your tray.

Vertical version

1. An adult (your teacher, for example) will cut a section from the middle of the bottle. This will become the opening of your greenhouse.
2. The vertical greenhouse version can be place directly on a table or suspended using a thread.

**For the vertical version,
an adult can help you cut a
door out of the side.**

3. Expose your greenhouse to sunlight, near a window
4. Place your plant inside and watch it grow!
